The Association of Desk and Derrick Clubs

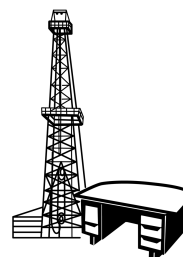

ADDC members work in many phases of the petroleum, energy, and allied industries; however, they are united in a common goal: To learn more about their industries in order to become more effective participants.

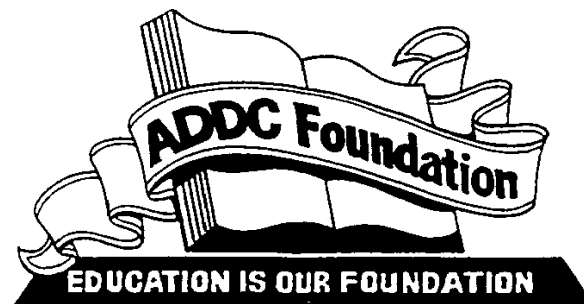
