




#### **CLUB PURPOSE**

#### Seatrax Field Trip

On October 17, 2009, Seatrax hosted a field trip for the Desk & Derrick Club of the Westbank. Fourteen members and guests were in attendance. The group was greeted by Mark Truxillo, Service Manager, who explained the day-to-day operations of Seatrax.

Seatrax has four locations. The Corporate office is in Houston, Texas. The Service offices are in Belle Chasse and Lafayette Louisiana, and their Manufacturing plant is in the United Kingdom. Seatrax employees about 450 personal combined among all locations. Seatrax specializes in Cranes used to assist in the operations on platforms, drilling rigs, dock front facilities and marine applications. There cranes are mostly installed on platforms in waters up to 350 feet in depth, and also found on drilling rigs in water up to 10,000 feet in depth. With manufacturing capability from the traditional two ton Popcorn crane to the Seaking 300 ton traditional crane, they can service just about every customer's needs.

The Westbank Desk & Derrick club was taken on a tour of the Belle Chasse service and remanufacturing facility. Mr. Truxillo encouraged questions throughout the tour. The facility in Belle Chasse is known for one of the top service companies in the crane industry. Along with our tour, we were able to visit the new crane rental division of Seatrax which is now servicing customers worldwide. We were able to view the competitor's cranes that were in for service as compared to those belonging to Seatrax. Many of the crane styles that we viewed on our tour are installed on well known platforms in the Gulf of Mexico such as Chevron, B.P. Thunder Horse, Exxon, and Shell. As well as the platforms, the same style cranes are installed on deep water drilling rigs, such as Diamond, Pride Offshore, Nabors and Blake Work Over and Drilling.

Mr. Truxillo made a surprise announcement stating that Seatrax in conjunction with their sister company Semco has just completed the newest and largest Class 280 Jack-Up Drilling Rig in there Lafitte, Louisiana location. We were able to take a road trip to visit and tour this facility and the largest Jack-Up Drilling Rig in the World. With a price tag of over Fifty Million Dollars and four hundred thousand man hours, this state of the art rig will be shipped out of the country within the next thirty days. Mr. Ron Bourgeois explained how each part of the vessel is fabricated and installed, while at the same time we were able to witness and view the pads for the next newest vessel, which will be larger than this one with a Class 320. These pads were 50' X 150' in diameter and weighed over forty tons. The new Class 320 vessel is the first time that this vessel is tempted to be manufactured with jack up legs of 9' 6" in diameters and 320 feet in length. This vessel will become the future World's largest Jack-Up Rig scheduled to be delivered in the later part of 2010.

Once both of our tours were completed, Mr. Truxillo invited The Desk & Derrick members to climb aboard the drilling rig, cranes, cabins, control rooms, engine rooms, and heliport to see how the daily operations are performed each and every day. One of our members was allowed to climb onto a crane and actually sit in the cabin. She was excited to see the actual process of how the crane operators performed their daily duties. This procedure was done with escorted safety and caution.

Finally, Seatrax was gracious enough to provide lunch for our club. Mr. Truxillo gave us some hand outs, and welcomed us with open arms. We had a great time and it was a fabulous learning experience for all.

Recommended daily needs for minerals are indicated in the chart below, along with other pertinent information.

Calcium	1000 mg	Macro	Muscle, heart and digestive system health, builds bone, supports synthesis and function of blood cells.	Dairy products, canned fish w/bones - salmon, sardines, green leafy vegetables, nuts and seeds	
Phosphorus	700 mg	Macro	A component of bones and energy processing and other functions	Milk, green leafy vegetables

Many elements have been suggested as essential, but such claims have usually not been confirmed. Definitive evidence for efficacy comes from the characterization of a biomolecule containing the element with an identifiable and testable function. One problem with identifying efficacy is that some elements are innocuous at low concentrations and are pervasive, so proof of efficacy is lacking because deficiencies are difficult to reproduce.

Relatively large quantities of sulfur are required, but there is no RDA as the sulfur is obtained from and used for amino acids, and therefore should be adequate in any diet containing enough protein.


There have been occasional studies asserting the essentiality of nickel, but it currently has no known RDA.

Arsenic, boron, bromine, cadmium, silicon, tungsten and vanadium have establish, albeit specialized, biochemical roles as structural or functional cofactors in other organisms. However, these elements appear not to be utilized by humans.


