





Dear Members:

In order to be a great leader, one must work constantly and diligently on his/her leadership skills. Here are a few tips to improve your speaking abilities:

**Know your subject.** Whether you are teaching a co-worker a new computer program or you are making a presentation to a large audience, you must know and understand the subject. Do your homework – read, surf the net, learn from others that already have the knowledge you need, etc.



September 2009 and discussed new business presented to the 2010 Board. Highlights from the B&P Meeting will be available soon to the club presidents for distribution to members.


