

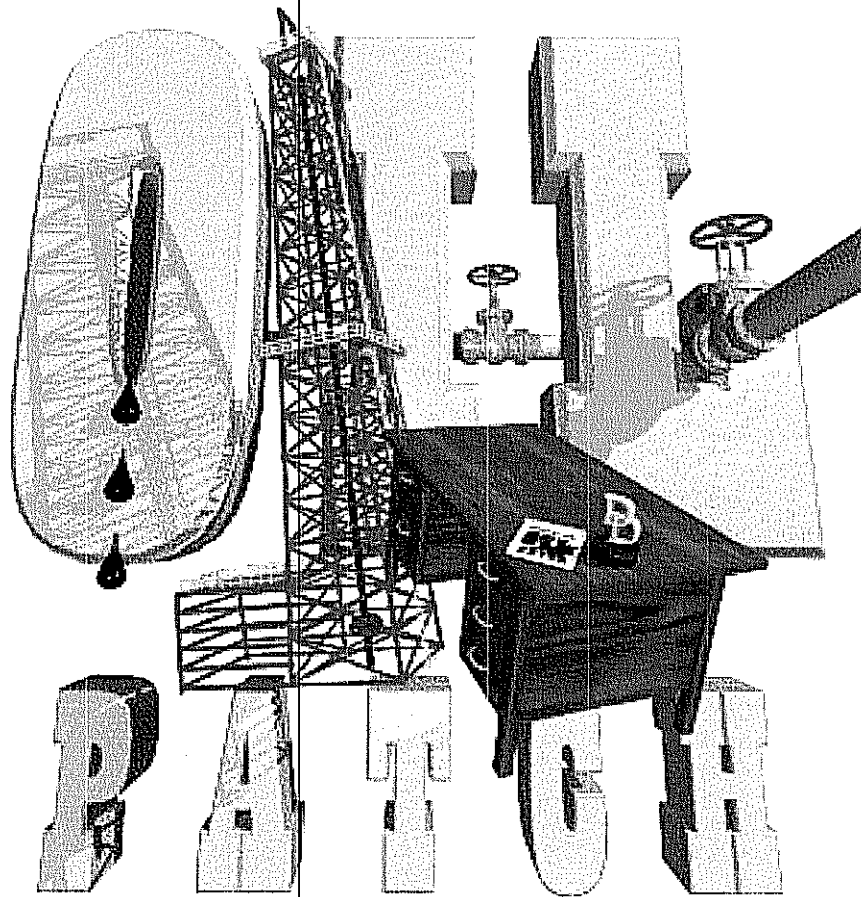

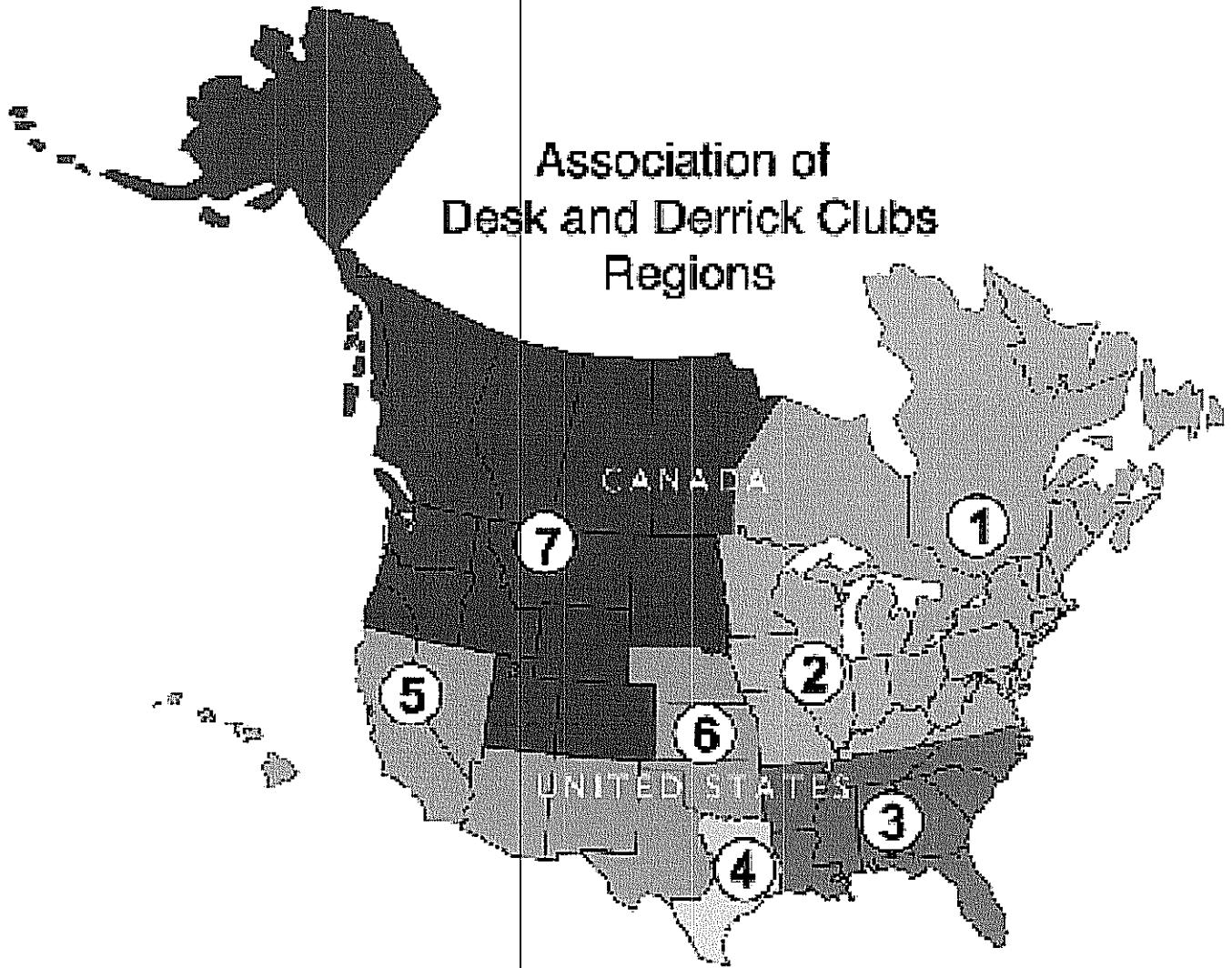

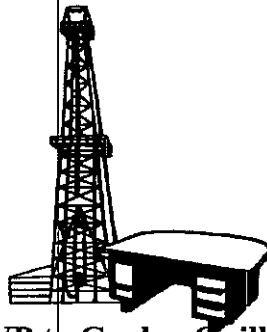
### CLUB PURPOSE

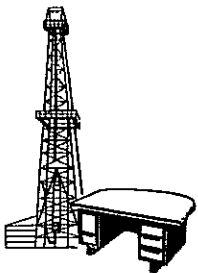
To: All Region III Members
