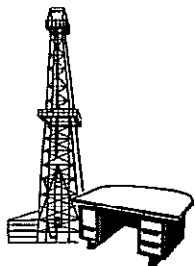
Greetings ADDC Members!

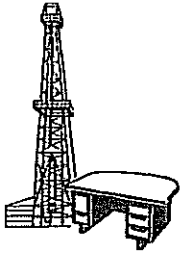





Education Background



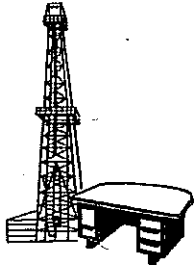
Participation in other Organizations

Dictators exert power by blaming others when things go wrong and they are usually poor listeners. To cope with this type of personality, one needs to:

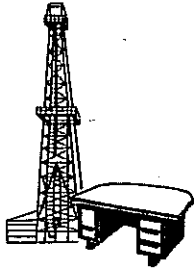
1. Deal strictly in facts.
