



#### MISSION STATEMENT


The mission of the club is to enhance and foster a positive image to the global community by promoting the contribution of the petroleum, energy and allied industries through education by using all resources available.






As we move into the holiday season, please be safe in your travels, and make sure you let your loved ones know how much you care about them. Don't assume people know what you feel. Tell them!

Westbank is known for its' fun loving spirit and it was shining in all its' glory for this Regional. Of course, the talk focused a lot on our great food in the Hospitality Room thanks to Angie's Mom, Audrey, who was well known and appreciated for her famous cooking. This time I was able to give my Presidents' report to the entire assembly and I could do a lot of bragging. It also gave me an opportunity to THANK all the members in Region III for their love & support given to me as I went through the difficult treatments for Breast Cancer. I even had hair again, so I was one happy D&D President.

Wichita, Kansas: Dorothy and the Wizard of Oz greeted us at Convention that year. We even had our very own Dorothy all dressed up with her red shoes to lead us in all the fun. I'm sure all of us can guess who was our Dorothy. We just could not get enough of pictures with the Tin Man and tried to figure out if we could take him home with us. It was another great convention with excellent field trips, seminars and entertainment.

MEMORIES!!!!All part of the wonderful times with friends made along the way. As I look back at my 29 years in this organization, I can't help but feel so honored to have been able to serve twice as your President. Memories can always be taken with you wherever you go and you can hold them in your heart for all your life.











