


#### **CLUB PURPOSE**







Public Relations Review

Clubs around the Association work hard to bring new members into their clubs. This is a great start, but it's only the beginning. Once you have members, how do you deliver on your promises? And how do you keep them coming back when their needs change? Retaining your Member's takes greater effort than recruiting them, and it all begins with the club experience.

The first thing to remember for a successful meeting is to keep it fun and respectful for all participants. Learning should be fun! While most members join to improve their speaking and leadership skills, they will grow more rapidly if they're enjoying their time spent in a club. Encourage speeches that share humorous stories, and make sure that observations always recognize what people do well.

Some members hesitate to try PR because they're afraid of being rejected by a member of the news media. But getting the buzz started means the member needs to step out of that comfort zone and contact people — especially those who don't know about Desk and Derrick — such as reporters and bloggers. News happens fast and the news media is always looking for a good story. Reporters and editors don't always have the resources to find you, so you need to help them. This is especially true of your local press. Offer them your club website or our association website.

One of the top reasons members don't renew their membership in any season is lack of time. It's important to be sensitive to your members' needs. For example, are members having trouble with the meeting time or duration? Does the meeting run too long? Are members unable to get to work on time after a meeting? Are they having trouble with evening hours or lunchtime on Tuesdays? Or is it something else? Find out and consider adjusting the club's schedule or tone accordingly if necessary. Of course, you can't please everyone, but if you're losing a lot of members, it's important to take note and act.

Remember to focus your club's educational program on meeting the members' needs. Those who benefit from an optimal experience in the club will return to build more skills, enjoy the camaraderie and find the success you all deserve.




With that said, I will treasure our friendships and wish everyone a very Merry Christmas and a Prosperous New Year!



#### Desk and Derrick Club of the Westbank College Scholarship Guidelines

#### General Guidelines for All Applicants:

- 1. Must submit application through an active Westbank D&D Member. All active Westbank Club Members are encouraged to apply for the scholarship, provided they meet the guidelines.
- Graduating high school seniors must provide copies of <u>both</u> GPA and ACT scores. Proof of <u>cumulative</u> GPA with a minimum of 2.5 and ACT of 21 is needed to qualify. Proof of these scores must be on an official school issued document with student name and ID#.
  - 2a. All graduating high school seniors must provide a Letter of Acceptance from the college or university attending.
  - 2b. Current college students must submit proof of <u>cumulative</u> GPA of 2.5 or higher on official school issued document with student name and ID#.
- 3. All applicants must submit completed application form, including all requested documentation to their Desk and Derrick Sponsor in time to be submitted to the Scholarship Chairman by March 15<sup>th</sup>. Incomplete applications or those received after the deadline will be disqualified.
- 4. No applicant will be granted more than four annual Scholarship Awards (need not be four continuous years).
- 5. All applicants must provide at least one letter of recommendation (from someone other than D&D Sponsor or immediate family member).
- 6. All applicants must provide letter or essay detailing intended field of study and educational goals.

#### Desk and Derrick Sponsor Responsibilities:

The Desk and Derrick Sponsor must write and submit a letter to the committee detailing their personal knowledge of the applicant.

The letter, the application, and all attachments, MUST be submitted to the <u>Scholarship Chairman</u> or be postmarked by March 15<sup>th</sup> and mailed to: Desk and Derrick Club of the Westbank Scholarship Chairman, P. O. Box 2875, Gretna, LA 70054-2875

Scholarships will be issued from available funds no later than June 30th of each year.

Scholarship checks will be issued jointly to the scholarship recipient and the appropriate college/university or college book store.




