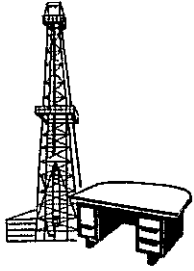
Club General Information Section:

Homeland Security & Emergency Preparedness

Emergency Operations Center

On Thursday July 14th 2011 at 6:00 pm the Westbank Desk & Derrick Club attended a Field Trip to the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) located on the 3rd floor at 8056 Hwy 23 Suite 308 in Belle Chasse, Louisiana. Michelle Lauer is the Director of the Facility who also provided us with sandwiches and soft drinks to enjoy prior to her presentation.

Michelle has worked in the response to and recovery from several large events in Plaquemines Parish such as : Hurricanes Katrina and Rita in 2005, Gustav, Ike and Oil Spill in 2008, the BP Spill and the Mississippi River Flooding Event in May 2011. She has played an integral part of the planning for all hazards that potentially affect Plaquemines Parish, the largest of those being weather – related emergencies. Plaquemines Parish has one of the most often sought after evacuation plans in the State and the Nation in relation to point – to – point sheltering. It has served as a model for others to follow and implement. Michelle offered wealth of experience through her knowledge of the National Incident Management System and the Incident Command Structure.

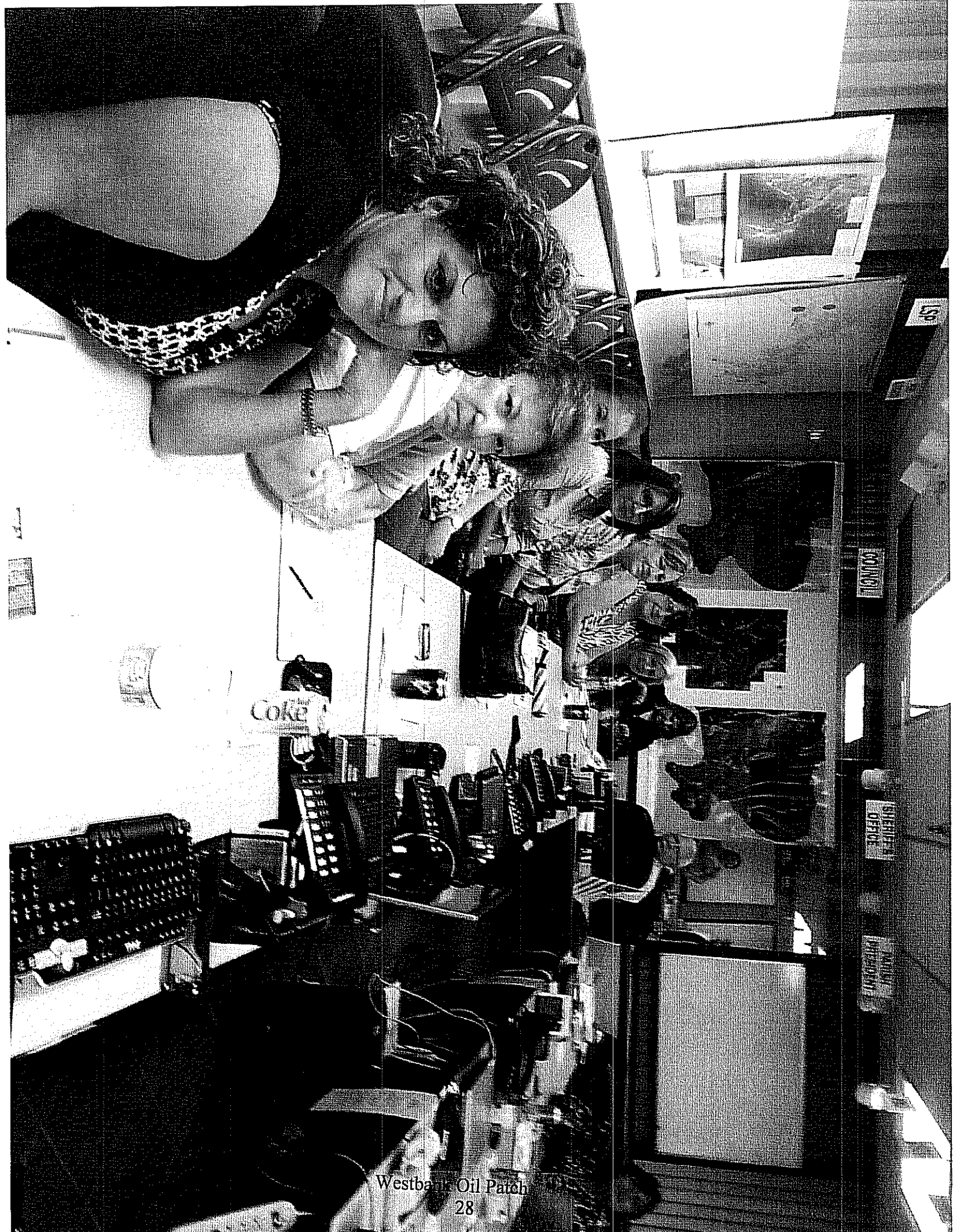
The EOC is a Resource Support for any and all hazards and emergencies within Plaquemines Parish. They are the communication link between the Parish and its citizens during an emergency. Also, communication with away teams in Baton Rouge and Red River Parish and the communication link between the Parish, the Region and the State during an emergency. This is a 24 hour operation, monitoring Parish camera system, 911 information and weather briefs.

The EOC will provide transportation, communications, public works, engineering, firefighting, mass care, housing, human services, urban search and rescue, public health, human services, oil and hazardous material response, public safety and security. The EOC will advise the Parish President declaring evacuations and emergencies and are the liaison support for the Red Cross, Salvation Army, Coroner's Office and telecommunications.

Michelle gave us a tour of the 911 Center and we witnessed the operators at their stations receiving calls. We also received some very good advice from Michelle in regards to Volunteer opportunities, she stated "After preparing yourself and your family for possible emergencies by getting a kit, making a plan and being informed, take the next step and get involved in preparing your community". This was a Great informative Field Trip that was enjoyed by all members.

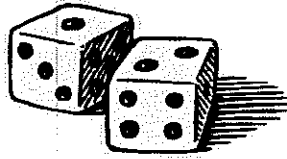
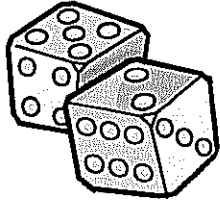
