




#### **CLUB PURPOSE**







Greetings,

The 60th Annual ADDC Convention will be held in St. Louis, Missouri, from September 21-25, 2011. All clubs are urged to send a Delegate and an Alternate to attend Convention and act on behalf of the club during business sessions. In order to serve in this capacity, an official credentials form (CRED1) must be completed and returned to me by mail or electronic mail.

The Cred1 form can be found on the ADDC website (www.addc.org) under Members Only, ADDC Forms Books. It is the third item in the second column entitled "Credential Delegate & Alt. ADDC - CRED1." All clubs must submit this form to me even if they will not be represented at Convention. THE DEADLINE IS MONDAY, AUGUST 1, 2011. Please send in your club's completed and signed form as early as possible; revisions can always be made at a later date.

All Delegates and Alternates attending Convention are required to check in with their respective Regional Representative at the Credentials table at least thirty (30) minutes prior to each business session. The table will be located just inside the meeting room. Delegates and Alternates will then be asked to produce a copy of their completed credentials form and sign a signature sheet. To eliminate confusion, Delegates and Alternates are requested to sign in AT THE SAME TIME.

Beginning with the first business session, each Delegate will be issued a numbered badge to wear during all business sessions. This badge will be the delegate's responsibility and must be retained and worn until the final business session on Saturday, at which time it should be returned to the proper Credentials Committee Representative.



Please remember: The deadline for submitting the form (CRED1) is Monday, August 1 2011, and the form must be completed and signed even if your club will NOT be attending Convention.



As always, if any members or Clubs have any questions or concerns do not hesitate to let me know.





November was our IAN with Lindy Boggs as our guest speaker held at English Turn.


Finally, its December, my last agenda to prepare and time to hand over the gravel to Lyn Harvey incoming President for 1992.
