Do not hesitate to contact me at any time with any questions or concerns you may have regarding your Club, Region or Association. I will do my very best to assist any way I can.

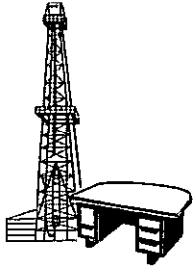

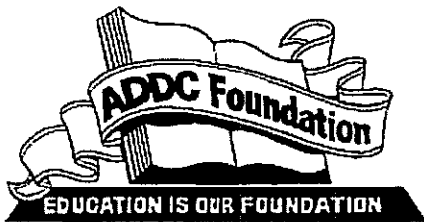
I encourage each of you to share your talents by serving our Association in 2012. The attached file contains a list of committee chairmen and region representatives – and openings still available.

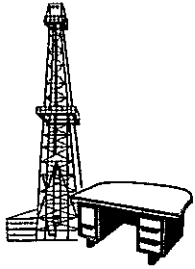

Dear Members,

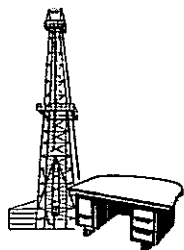
