

Dear Members,

Summer is upon us full force and everyone seems to be away enjoying themselves.

Earlier I had sent out a request for an update on each Region, what their Clubs have been doing to recruit new members and retain the present ones.

I only received a response from a few but it sounds as though our membership is hard at work canvassing for Desk and Derrick.

Exciting things are happening in Region I, with seven clubs and 297 members. They are working hard to break the 300 membership milestone in 2012. One club doubled its membership by holding a Membership Meet and Greet. At last count there were 50 new members added this year.

Along with building on membership, Region I has been giving out scholarships; helping out communities by providing clothing and food to needy families; conducting food drives to restock food banks; sponsoring patients at nursing homes; and sending care packages to soldiers. They are also assisting to educate school children by donating almost 2,000 Energy Activity Books (EAB) and 40 hardbound "Energy 4 Me" books.

Recently in Region II, 2012 ADDC President Judi Adams, Little Egypt Club President Marsha Bundy and Linda Welty, Region II Director, attended the Kentucky Oil and Gas Association Convention and Trade Show. They set up a Desk and Derrick booth and held a draw for a basket of chocolates as they collected business cards as entries. They displayed copies of the DDJ and EAB's and gave out ADDC brochures. In return they will receive a list of 12 companies from the Kentucky Oil and Gas Association that could become supportive of starting a club in Kentucky.


Later in Evansville, IN they presented 13 members of the Tri-State Club their charter, welcoming them as a new club of Region II. At last count there are 124 members in Region II.

Region V reports 12 clubs and 286 members. Like a lot of clubs, there is the constant struggle of losing members to companies downsizing, the slow economy in general or the passing of our beloved long time members. Recruiting is mainly word of mouth or by working with someone that is already a member. Publicizing meetings in the newspaper and highlighting guest speakers also has helped increase membership in some clubs.

Region VII has five clubs and at last count 285 members. There are the possibilities of a club starting in northern Alberta, one in Utah and one or two in booming North Dakota. Region VII members also give back to their communities by holding fundraisers for supplying food for food banks and providing clothing for needy families or women who require career attire to get back into the work force. Assisting in the education of children in schools with EAB donations and educating the general public about the petroleum and allied industries are part of the region's regular activities.

I am so proud to be part of an Association where there is so much caring and giving and where our "Greater Knowledge, Greater Service" motto has long been the key to opening many doors of opportunity. Hats off to all the members of the Association!


