At last spring is here, once again!



I would like to remind all the Region III Presidents that the program reports should be completed and forwarded no later than a week after the monthly meeting. It is very important that this is done each month.






There are some GREAT opportunities to involve your communities and capture their attention to spread the word about Desk and Derrick.
