This past month the ADDC Board approved items in our monthly board meeting I would like to share with you:

- In order to streamline the financial reporting the ADDC Treasurer and the ADO perform each month, instead of two companies (Operations and Convention), the financial reporting will be one company (ADDC) with four separate accounts (Operations Checking, Operations Money Market, Convention Checking, and Convention Money Market).
- The Board also approved the addition of a "Donate" button on the main page of the ADDC website. This will allow supporters to donate online and can choose who they want to donate to, whether it is a regional meeting or convention.

- Another item of business is allowing Convention registration and payment to be online via the main page of our website to members and guests. I will note, it will take a little time to get the online donations and Convention registrations set up on the website. I will let you know when we are up and running!

I hope everyone will be able to make good use of the ADDC Business Card template that was recently sent out and can be found on the website. How did you like getting a direct email from the ADDC President? It was our first try at sending out a mass email to the membership. There will be more to come in the near future! There are a few more items the Board would like to accomplish this year so we are working towards those goals. Please know the Board is listening to you, the membership. 
