Scholarship Guidelines

General Guidelines for All Applicants:

- All applications shall be submitted through a Sponsor; sponsor must be an active Westbank Desk and Derrick Club member in good standing.
- All applicants must submit completed, appropriate (High School or College) application form and all required documentation to Sponsor by March 1st.
- All applicants must provide a letter or essay detailing intended field of study and educational and personal goals. Include information on any extracurricular activities, such as community service, clubs, hobbies, employment, etc.
- All applicants must provide at least one (1) letter of recommendation from a school official, career counsellor, teacher, or professor on school or business letterhead.

Graduating High School Seniors:

- Must provide copies of <u>both</u> GPA (minimum 2.75) and ACT scores (minimum 23) or equivalent SAT scores.
 - Scores must be provided on official documents (transcript and official test results) with student name.
- 2. Must provide a Letter of Acceptance from the college or university attending.

Current College Students:

- Must provide proof of cumulative GPA (minimum 2.75).
 - Score must be provided on official school transcript with student name.

Incomplete applications or those received after the March 1st deadline will be disqualified.

Scholarship checks will be issued jointly to the scholarship recipient and the appropriate College/University. Scholarship checks must be cashed within the 180-day time period per banking regulations or the funds will be forfeited.



For those of you affected by the Arctic Blast of Winter Weather in the past week, I hope each of you remained safe and warm! Here in South Louisiana, we received RECORD Snowfall (yes, you read that right...SNOW in the South) last week and we are still thawing out! Unlike our friends in the north, we are completely unprepared and unaccustomed to any snowfall, much less the 8" to 10" we received in 1 day (which was followed by record cold temperatures of 3 degrees!) so we were completely shut in for 3 days and boy, does cabin fever set in!

Your 2025 Board of Directors is hard at work for YOU, the members, and boy did we work hard for you during the Budget & Planning meeting on 1/25/25. With 100% participation, all members were well represented and alot of business was discussed and voted on to become better stewards of the Association funds and business activities. To begin, the Board approved moving funds from the current Operations Money Market account to two (2) CD's (one for 1 year and 1 for 2 years) to earn additional revenue in interest vs letting the funds continue to receive very very minimal interest. Additionally, we approved a conversion of the Association's financials to Quickbooks online to provide better control for YOUR elected Board of Directors over our finances and approved the hiring of a CPA firm (for a very reasonable cost) to file our Association tax returns and ensure that we are fully compliant with IRS rules and regulations. It was also approved to reinstate the ADDC Club President pins to reward those leaders who step up to lead their clubs and we hope to have those ordered and received by the Region Meetings.

The 2025 Association Budget was approved with a balance in the BLACK and we will regularly monitor to ensure the Association funds are well protected and managed properly! The 2024 FRC committee is finalizing their review of the 2024 finances and we hope to have a report out to membership soon. January 2025 Membership Meeting Presentation "How Gasoline is Made – Refinery Process"



Generally, people associate the Oil & Gas Industry with gasoline for their vehicles and transportation. They do not realize the steps needed to transform fossil fuels which are

millions of years old to clear, clean gasoline to power their vehicles.

The YouTube video shown provides the 7 Basic Steps in the refining process:

- 1. Extracting or Drilling Obtaining the crude
- Distillation breaking the crude down such as propane, kerosene, gasoline, naphtha, heavy oils
- Fuel Enhancement Catalytic Cracking -

Catalytic cracking is a chemical process used in petroleum refining to break down large hydrocarbon molecules into smaller, more valuable ones, primarily gasoline and diesel.

- Reforming, Optimize Increase Octane rating (cleaner engine – to help it run more efficiently)
- Final Blending Additives: Detergents, smell, helps fuel storage preparation
- Quality Control Testing, assure final product, where you purchase gasoline, it is all the same.
- 7. Storage & Distribution


