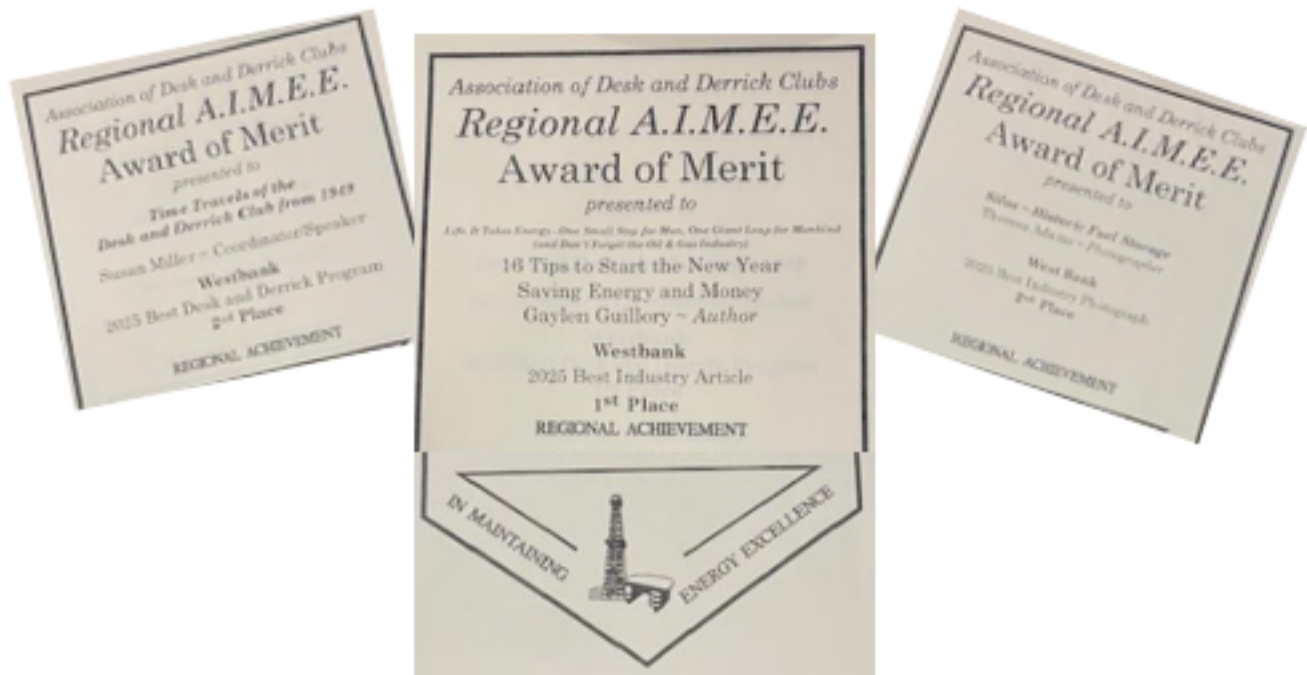
Gaylen Guillory won the 50/50 drawing of \$27.50.
